
A place they call HOME PROJECT PROPOSAL



Summary

The **Walkfree Kids** – are **a dance/music group** founded in 2019 by Kizito Henry in **Nyendo slums in Masaka, Uganda**. Currently the foundation has thirty-six kids from less privileged backgrounds and families, and we provide **a solid hope** for the orphaned, vulnerable, deprived and destitute children seeking a second chance to life.

Since 2019, we have had **24 children missing** from the group without a trace and today we are having 17 **children** living independently without a place to call home. These kids

face **multiple deprivation** and from the start all they share is a belief in **their talents and skills** to get a brighter future.

The **Place They Will Call Home** will create a safe, nurturing, and supportive environment as we nurture these young talents into responsible, creative and inspiring leaders.

The **Project Grand Cost is USD \$28,000** for the construction of the home; this cost does not include the land because we already have the land which was bought by Save The Child Foundation USA.

Justification

These 17 kids are living independently as street children! We believe these kids can change their lives when given a chance to a home, a chance to learn, a chance to create, and a chance to grow free from fear.


They are orphaned, abandoned, and displaced due to poverty, domestic violence, or neglect. We have brought them together through music, dance and drama and their have unleashed their potentials, attracting many friends through their unique movement and creativity. The program continues to safeguard them from risk of falling into cycles of crime, substance abuse, and chronic homelessness however the challenge is after the training they have to return back to the streets.

THE GOAL	OBJECTIVES
To construct and operationalize a home that accommodates 17 street children within 12 months.	1. Provide safe housing, food, clothing, and health care.
	2. Offer formal and informal education, free performing arts skilling, and ICT skills.
	3. Deliver basic amenities such as clean water, food, electricity, female hygiene products and more.
	4. Facilitate family tracing and reintegration where possible.
